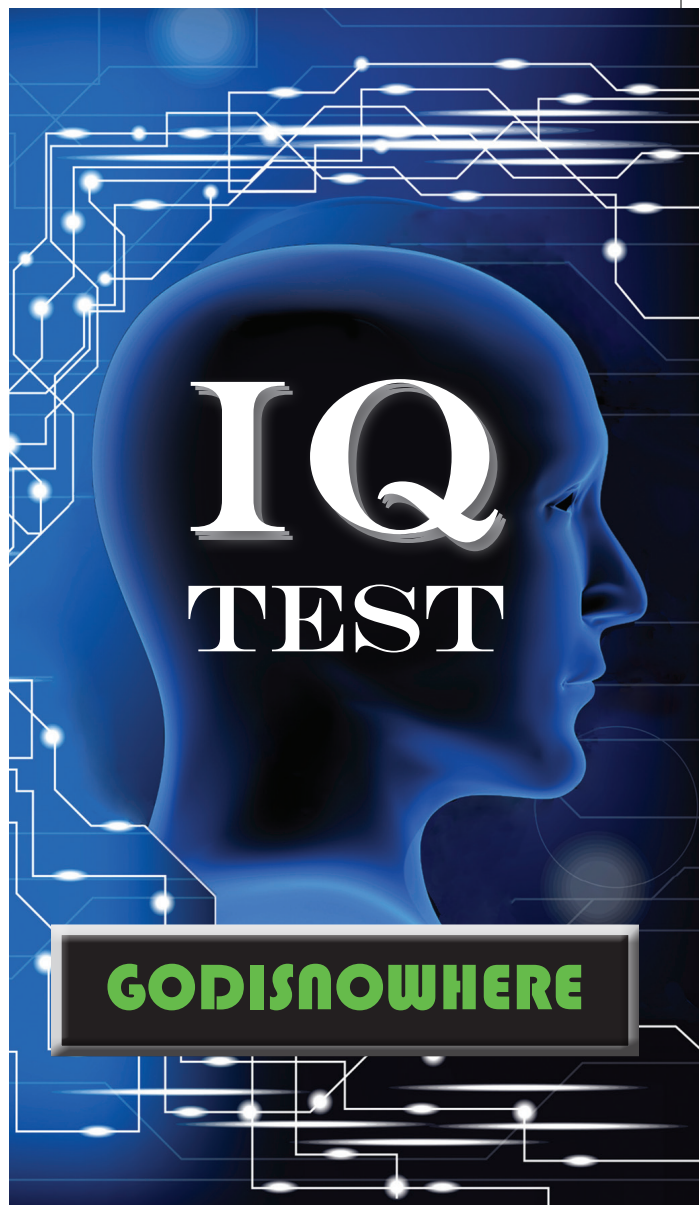

GOD IS NOWHERE

Perhaps you read, "God is nowhere." The letters also say, "GOD IS NOW HERE." A great percentage of people believe in God, but to many His presence isn't real. The Bible says, *"In Him we live, and move, and have our being"* (Acts 17:28). The Bible also says that we are separated from Him by sins we have committed. *"But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid His face from you, that He will not hear"* (Isaiah 59:2).

"Sin" is breaking God's Law. *"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God"* (Romans 3:23). God's laws are stated in the Ten Commandments. Let's see if you have sinned. Have you ever lied (even a "white" lie) or stolen (the value is irrelevant)? If so, you are a lying thief. *"Thou shalt not steal. Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour"* (Exodus 20:15-16). If you've lusted, you've committed adultery in your heart. *"But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart"* (Matthew 5:28). If you've hated someone, the Bible says you are a murderer.

"Whosoever hateth his brother is a murderer: and ye know that no murderer hath eternal life abiding in him" (I John 3:15).

If you have broken any of the Ten Commandments (Exodus 20:1-17, summarized in the poem below), you are in big trouble.
