Salvation is not about doing things, it's about trusting in Christ and what He has finished for us on the cross. He has won for us the victory over sin and death and all we have to do is believe that fact with our heart.

If you have been relying on something or someone other than Jesus, but now agree with God on how to be saved, then right now you need to get it right with the Creator. If you will pray something like this:

"Lord I know I am a sinner and I realize I need a Savior. I believe that Jesus died for my sins. Please Father forgive me of my sins and the best I know how, I am now asking Jesus to come into my heart and save me. I am trusting in Him and Him alone to save me and guarantee my place in Heaven as the Word of God promises. Thank you for saving me for all eternity. Amen."

If you have chosen to accept and receive Christ as your Savior, I want to be the first to congratulate you. **"Welcome to the Winning Side!!!"**


The Bible says in I John 5:13, *"These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life."*

What do I mean by missing Heaven by 18 inches?

I am very concerned that there are 1,000's of people professing they are saved, who are depending on their church attendance, baptism, tithing, or their religious works. The Bible says in Acts 16:31, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved." The word "believe" does not mean to acknowledge Jesus as existing on earth, or that He lived, or merely stating a mental asset to a fact. "Believe" means to place total and complete trust in Him and Him alone for eternal life. There is no promise in the Bible for those who partially believe in Christ.

In James 2:19, the Bible says that, "*the devils also believe.*" Friends, almost every religion and cult on earth believes that Jesus exists. Even Muslims believe in Jesus, they believe He was a great prophet. The problem is that they have not believed on Him in their heart.

That's what I mean by missing Heaven by 18 inches. It's generally 18 inches from your head to your heart. You have to place all your trust in Him. The problem is that they don't trust in Him with their heart, by faith, to save them or to get them into Heaven; therefore, they have no salvation. My friend, if you are counting on anything other than Jesus and what He did for us on the cross, you are still lost!!! "To be almost saved is to be totally

lost!!!" Jesus said of Himself in John 14:6, "*I am the way, the truth, and the life, no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me.*" Can't you see that clearly in the Scripture? Without the "way" there is no going, without the "truth" there is no knowing, and without the "life" there is no living!!! I am so afraid that 1,000's of people across our land are depending on the wrong things to get them into Heaven. By the way, I'm talking about many devoted church members today!!!

In Matthew 7:22-23 Jesus says, "*Many will say unto me in that day, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?*" Jesus says to them in verse 23, "*And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.*" Jesus was speaking to some of the most religious people that had ever been on earth. They were doing good works but with the wrong motives and with the wrong heart. These people knew who Jesus was but they had not received Him into their hearts. You might say that they had a head knowledge of Jesus but they had never trusted Him as Savior.

The purpose of this tract is for you to make sure that you have gotten Jesus from your head to your heart. Have you just been a fan of Jesus or a follower? Have you personally trusted Him and Him only to save you from your sin? Jesus said in Matthew 16:13-17 & Mark 8:27-29, "*Whom do men say that I the Son of Man am?*" We have to make the right decision about who Jesus is!!! Some said he was

John the Baptist, some said one of the prophets, but Peter said "thou art the Christ (the one that the Scriptures have been talking about from the beginning), the son of the living God."

On the cross Jesus uttered 7 cries. One was "*It is Finished*" (John 19:30). The Greek term for this is Tetelesti, which means totally and completely paid in full, there is absolutely nothing else to be done!!! All of the sacrificing, labor, and work for the cause of salvation is DONE!!! What was done? What was the "It?" "It," was the payment for the sin debt of all mankind!!! Jesus did not have any sin in Him. God laid on Him the sins of all mankind, both past, present, and future.

Ephesians 2:8-9 says, "*For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest any man should boast.*" Friend, we are saved by the grace of God. That grace was giving His Son. A gift is something we are given, with no attachments. A gift is something that we give to someone not expecting anything in return. If one expects something in return it ceases to be a gift.

My friend, is this tract talking to you? God's Word says in 2 Corinthians 13:5, "*Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith.*" Have you been confused or maybe even deceived? The Bible says in Proverbs 14:12, "*There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.*"
